Inbound, storage, fulfillment and control are designed as one connected operating flow.

Expected receipts

Purchase-order-linked arrivals, receiving queues and backorders.

Barcode operations

Scan products, packages, locations and transfers with compatible hardware.

Multi-location stock

Warehouses, zones, aisles, shelves, bins and hierarchical locations.

Putaway logic

Direct products toward the right storage location based on configured rules.

Traceability

Lots, serial numbers, packages and expiration handling where required.

Internal movement

Transfers, cross-warehouse resupply and location-to-location workflows.

Replenishment

Min/max rules, forecasted needs and review of future demand.

Pick / pack / ship

One-, two- or three-step delivery flows based on operating complexity.

Advanced picking

Batch, wave and cluster methods for higher-volume operations.

Returns and exceptions

Customer returns, vendor returns, scrap and backorder handling.

Counting and adjustment

Cycle counts, full counts, relocations and inventory corrections.

Visibility and reporting

Stock by location and date, movement history, exceptions and valuation links.

CONFIGURED TO THE OPERATION

Available scope depends on the selected Odoo edition, enabled modules, hardware and final workflow design. RKieh configures, integrates and customizes the solution around the client's actual operating model.

Finance can move from retrospective bookkeeping toward timely operational control because sales, purchasing, inventory and approvals are connected to the same source transactions.
